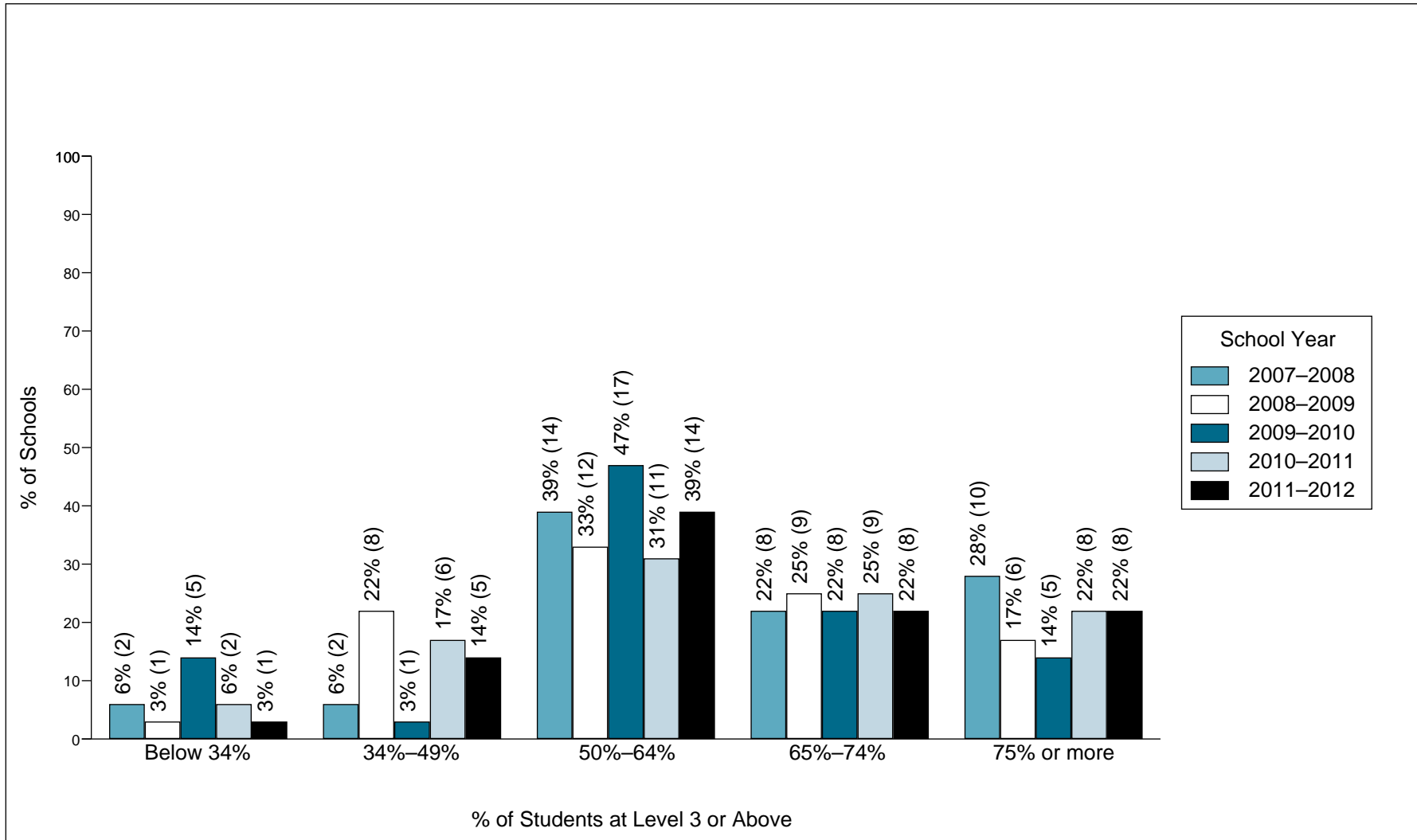

Distribution of School Results Over Time: Percentage and Number of Schools with Results in Specified Ranges

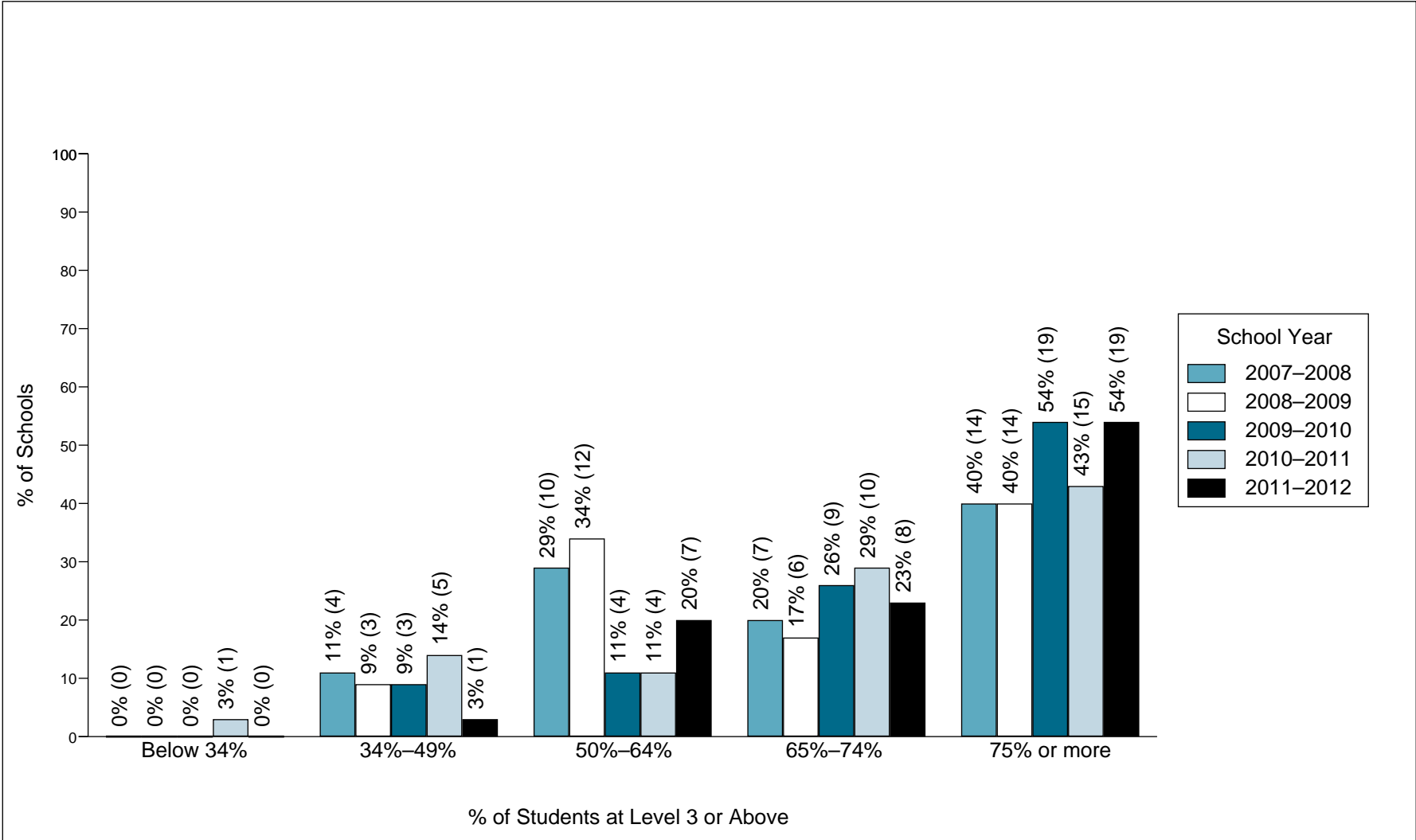

Only schools with 15 or more students in each of the five years are included in the graph: 36 of the 40 schools (90%).



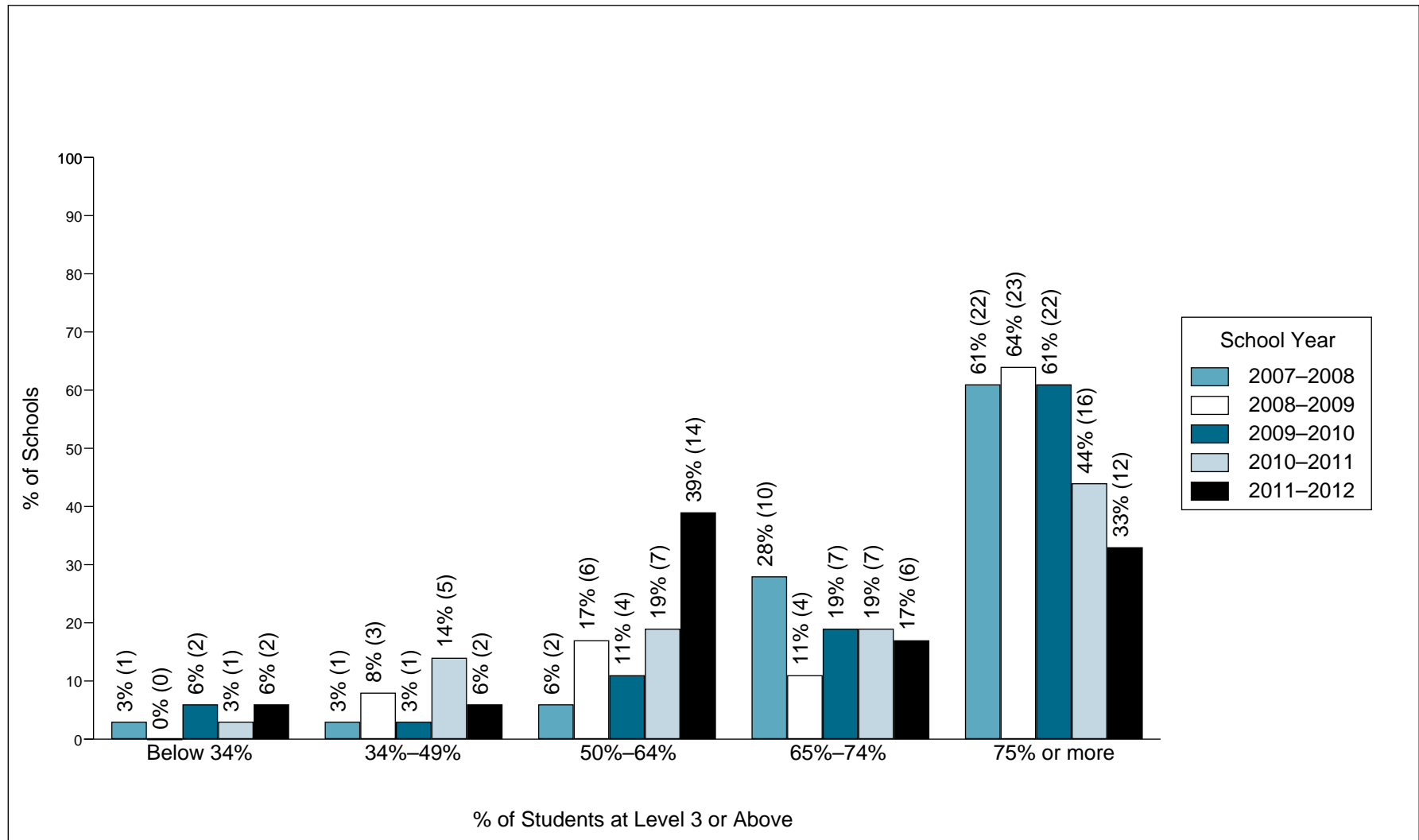

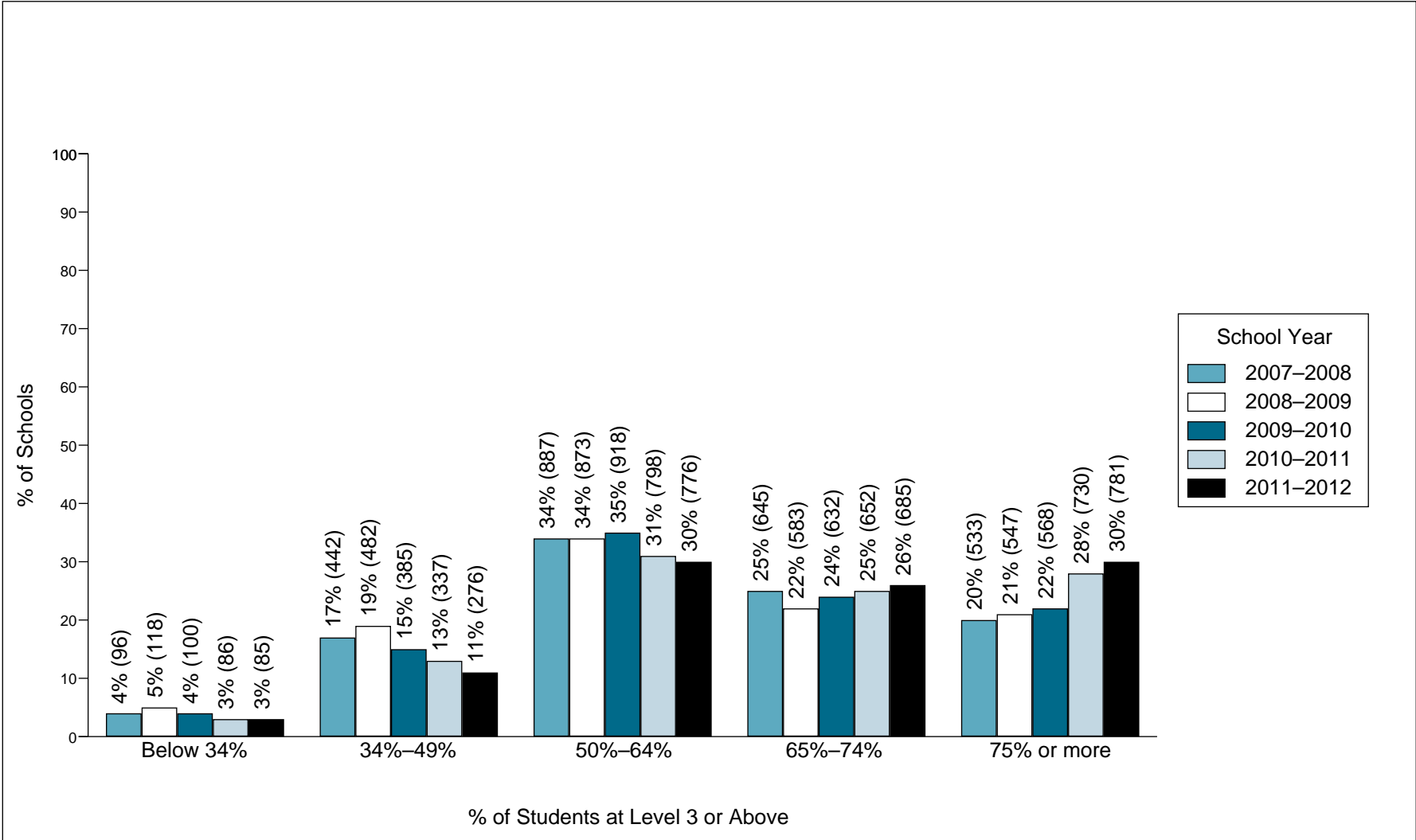

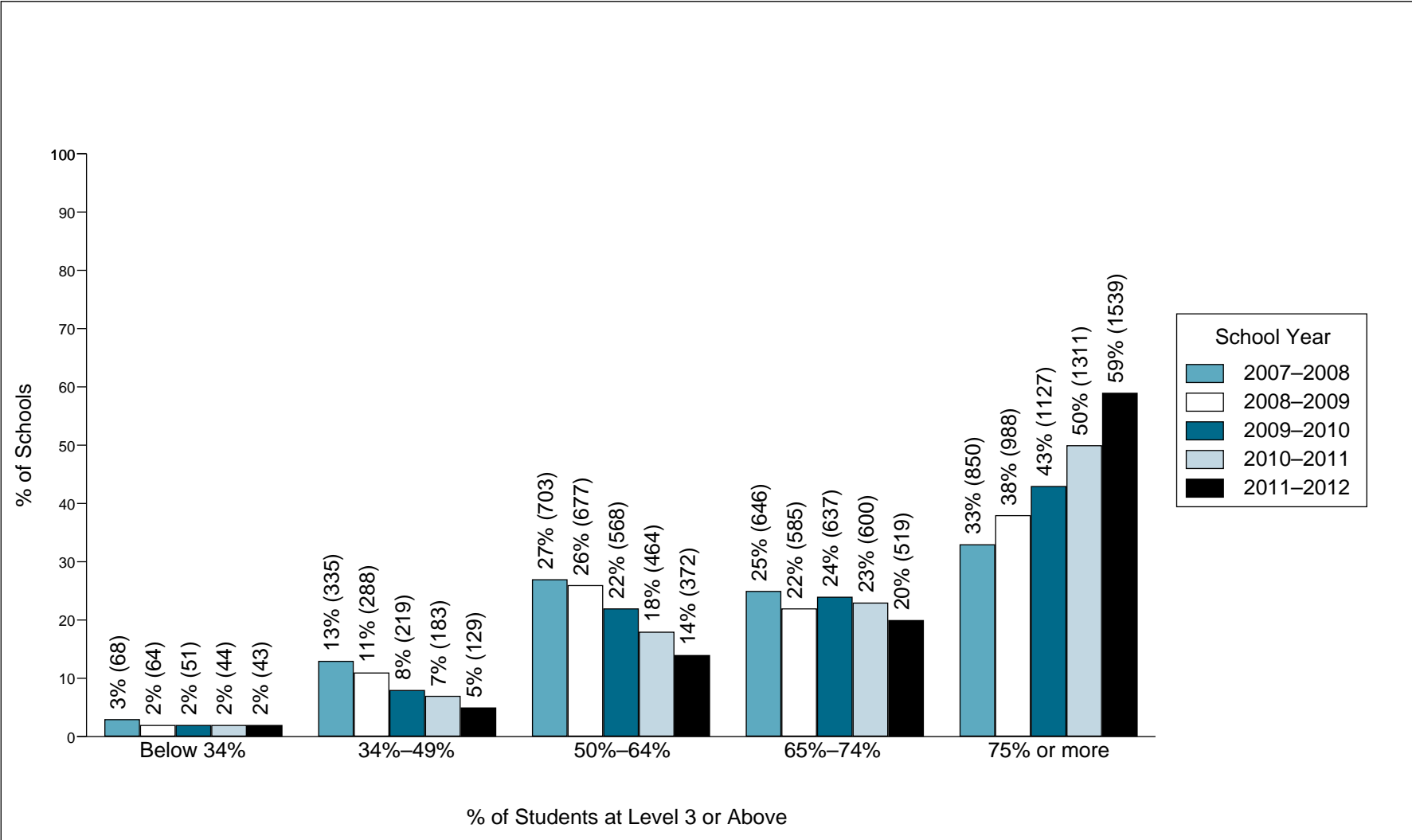

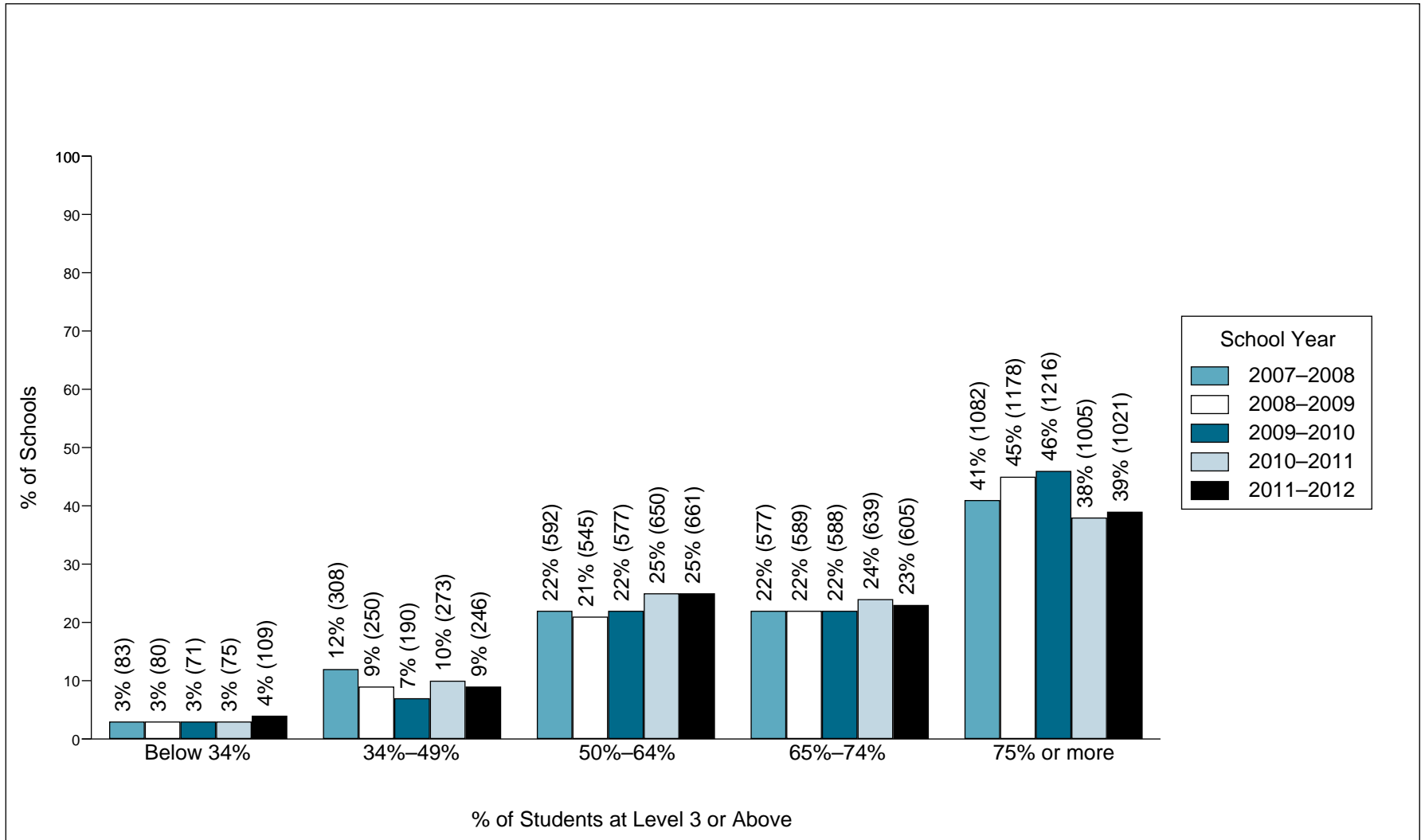
