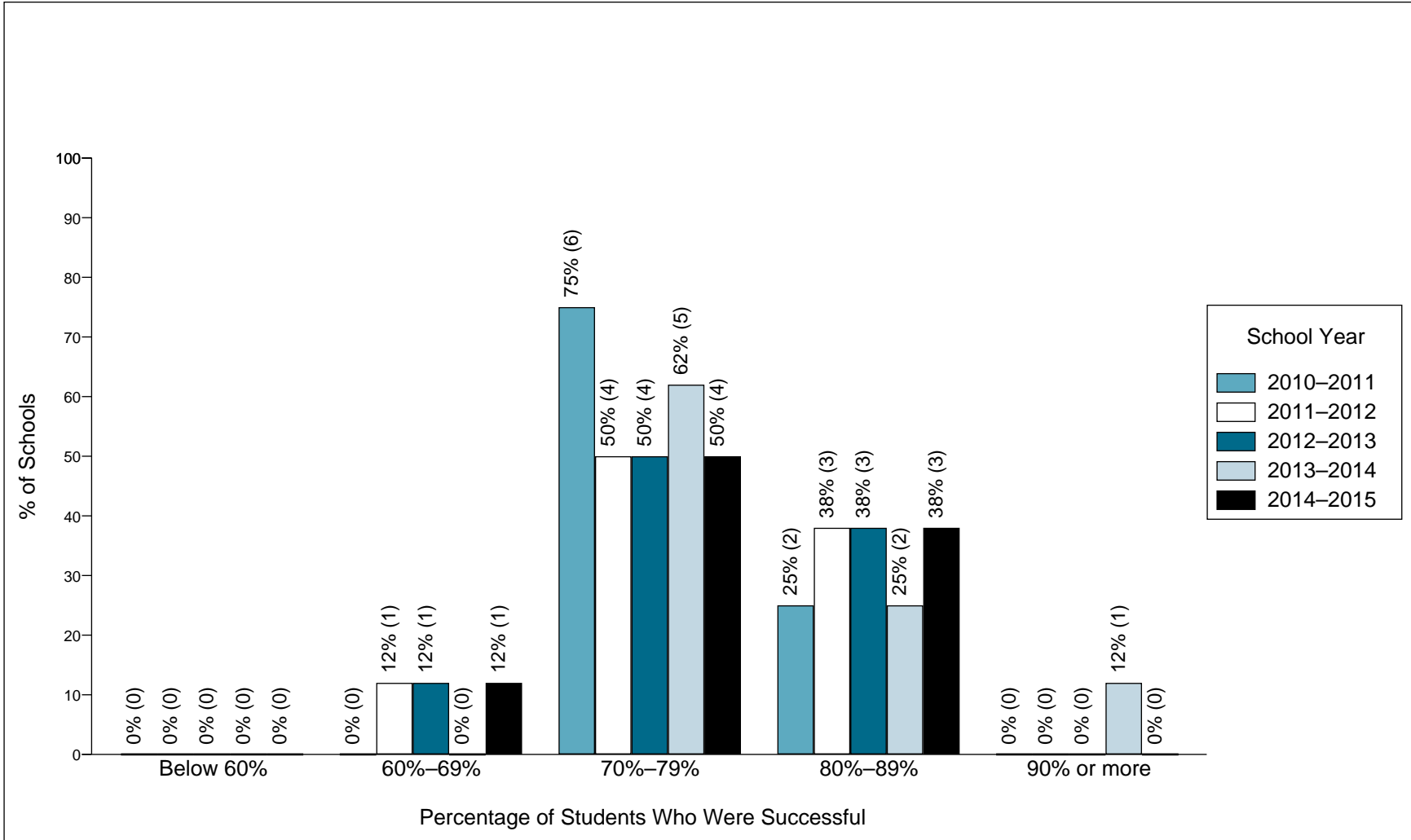




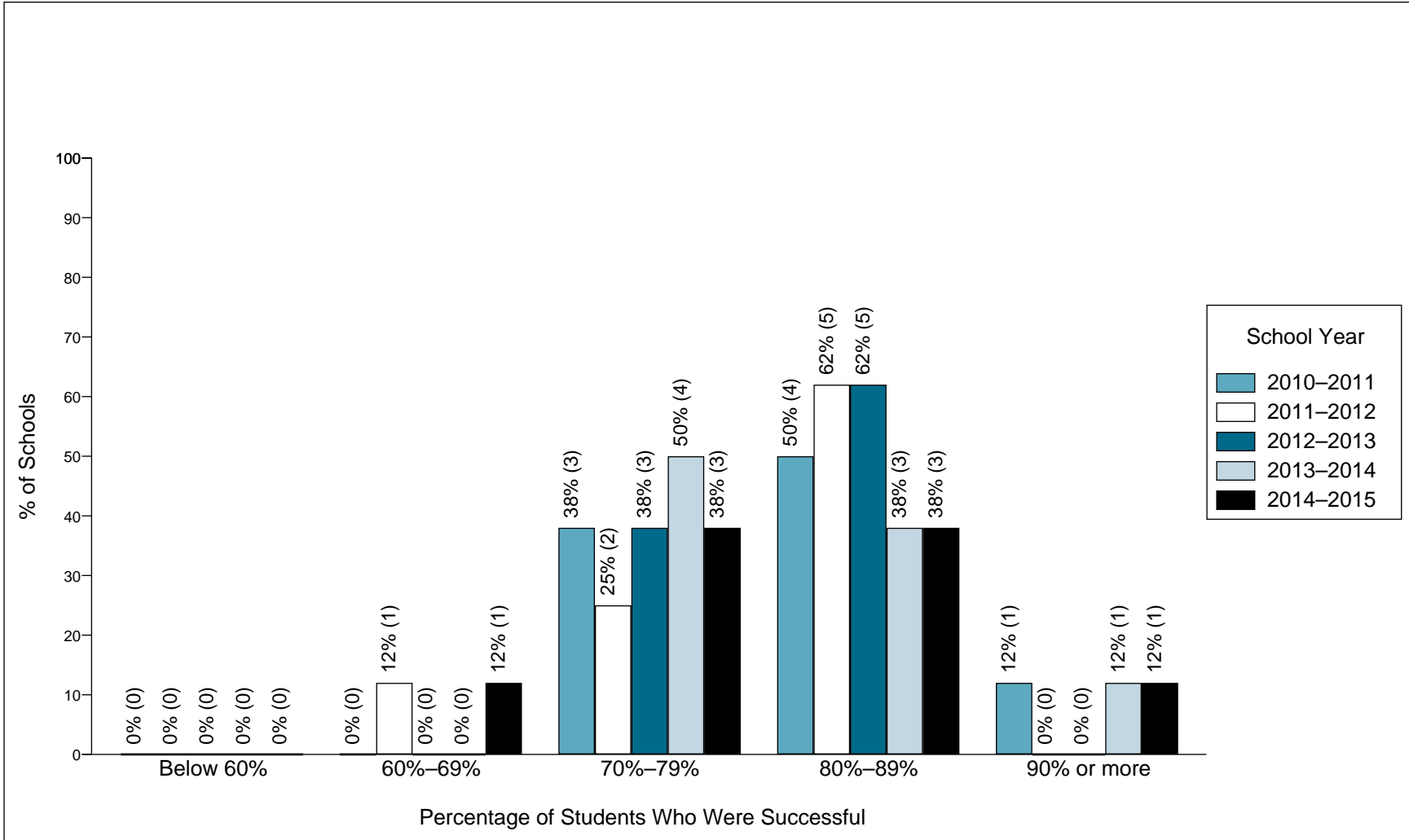
**Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test, 2014–2015**

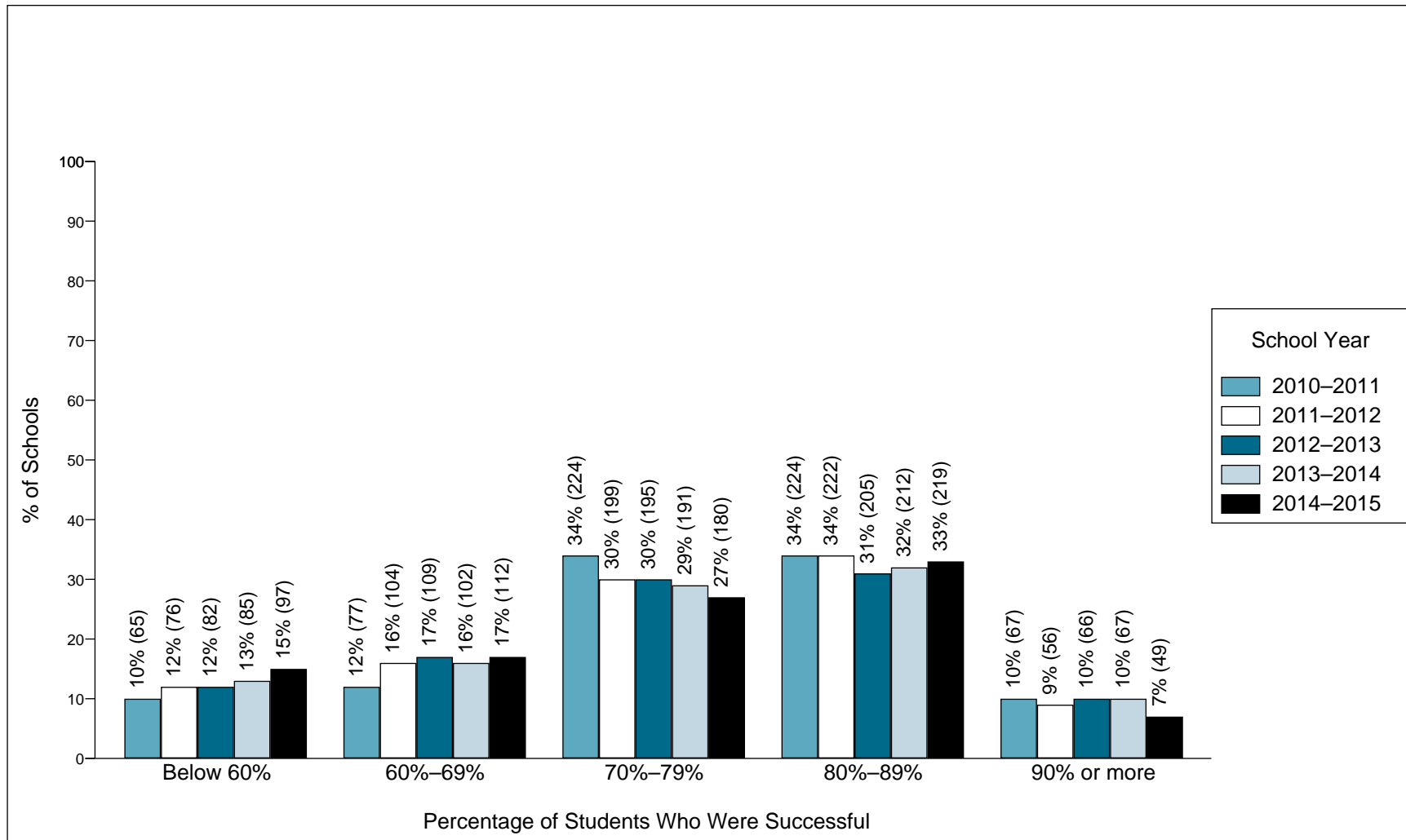

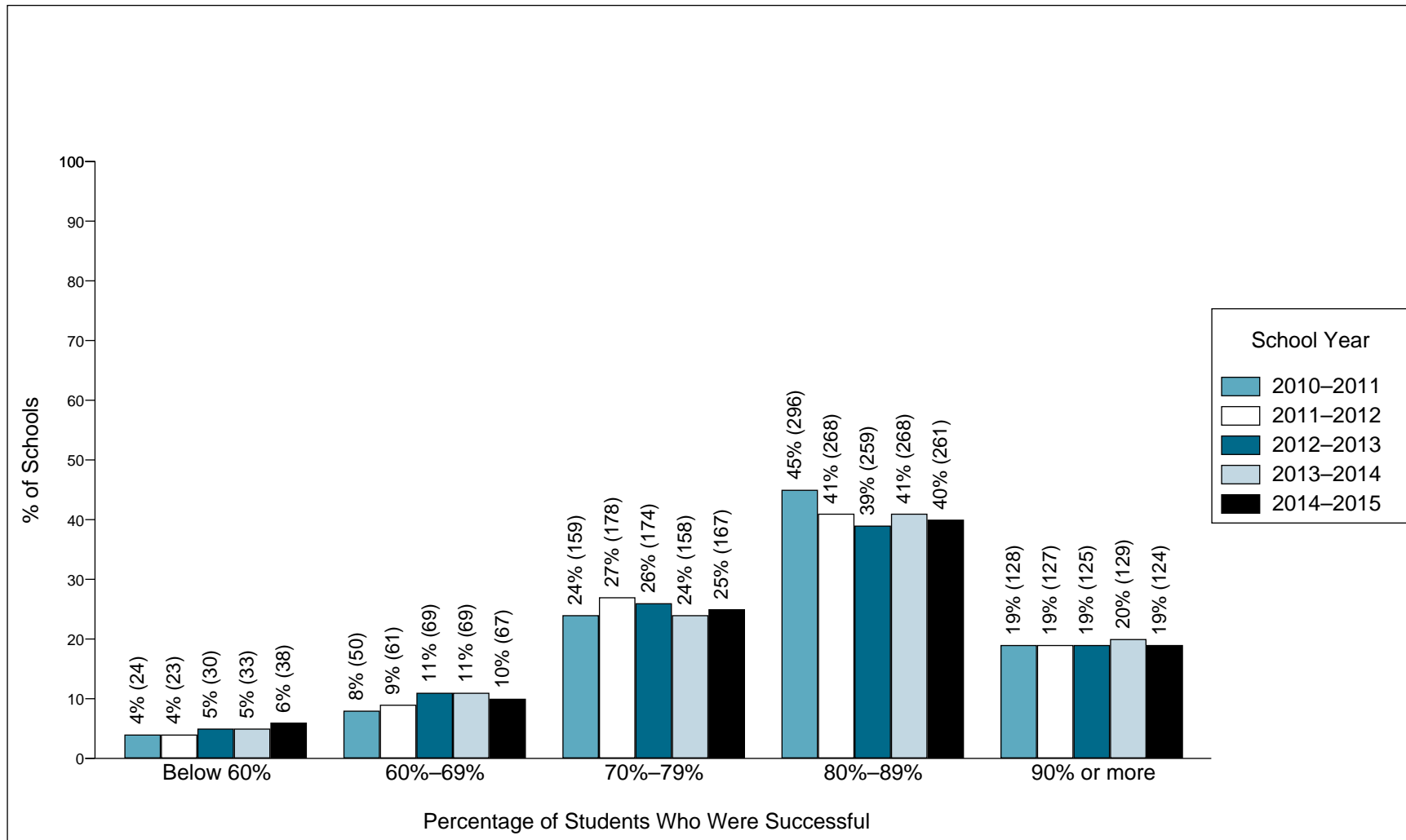
