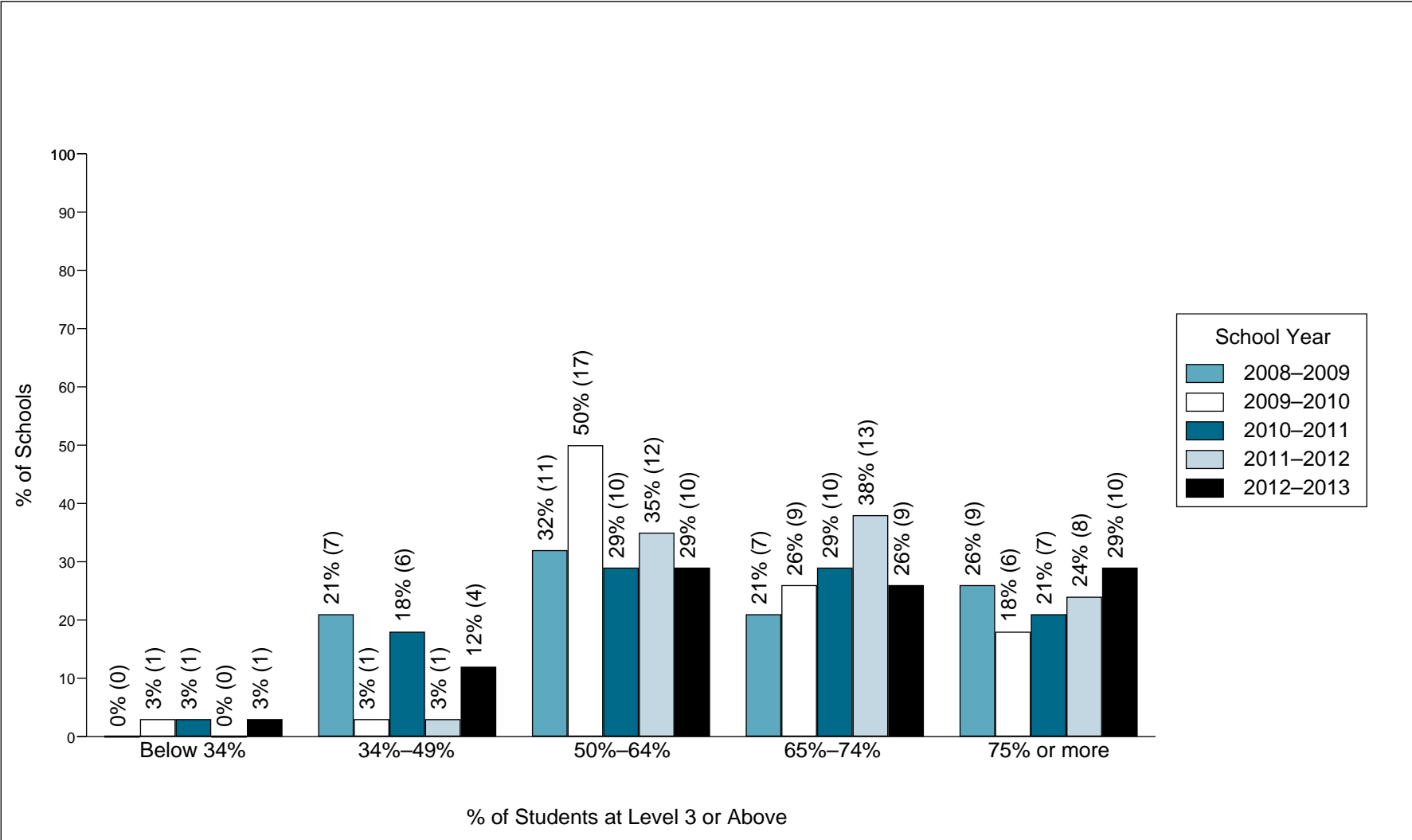

### Grade 3 Reading



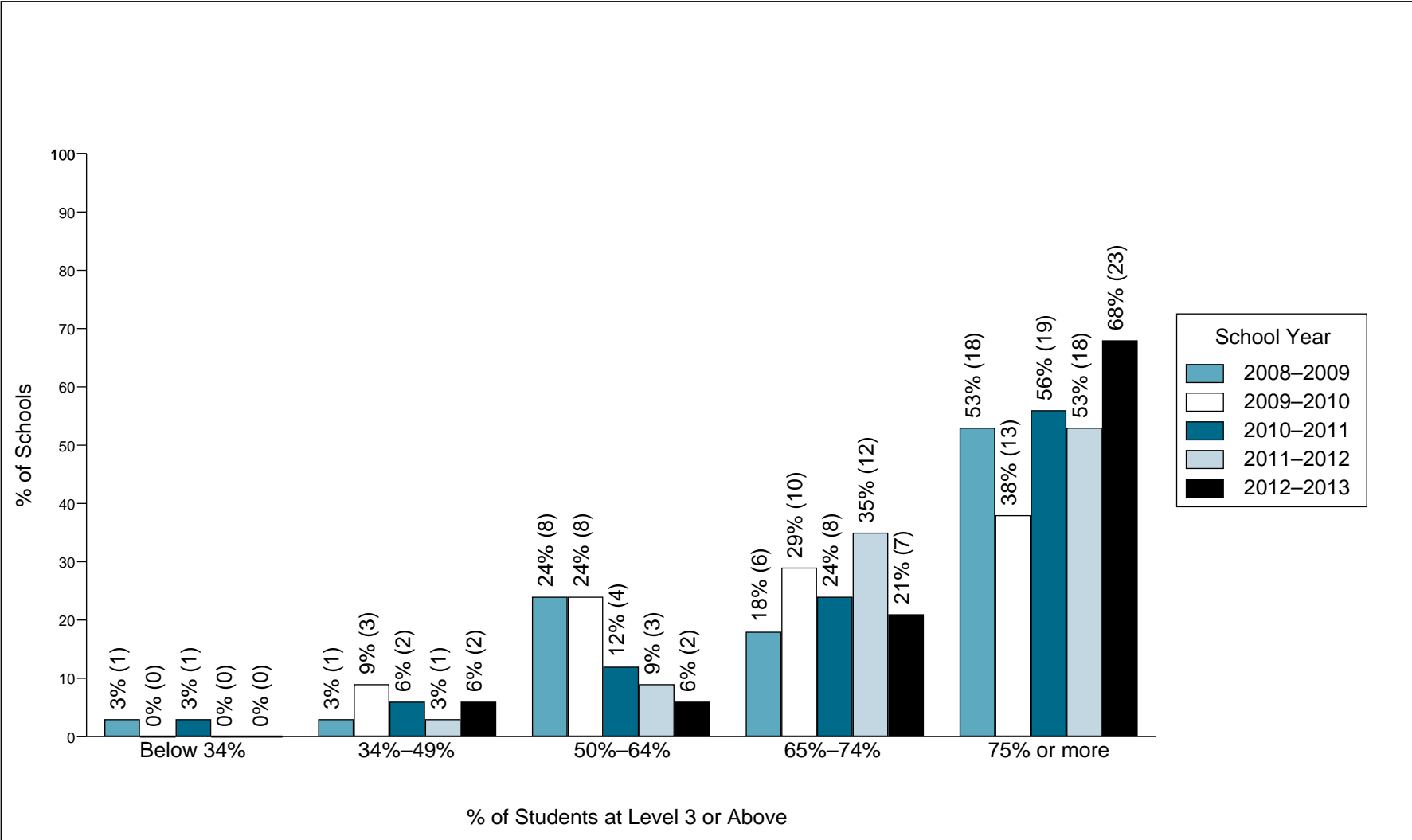

## Distribution of School Results Over Time: Percentage and Number of Schools with Results in Specified Ranges

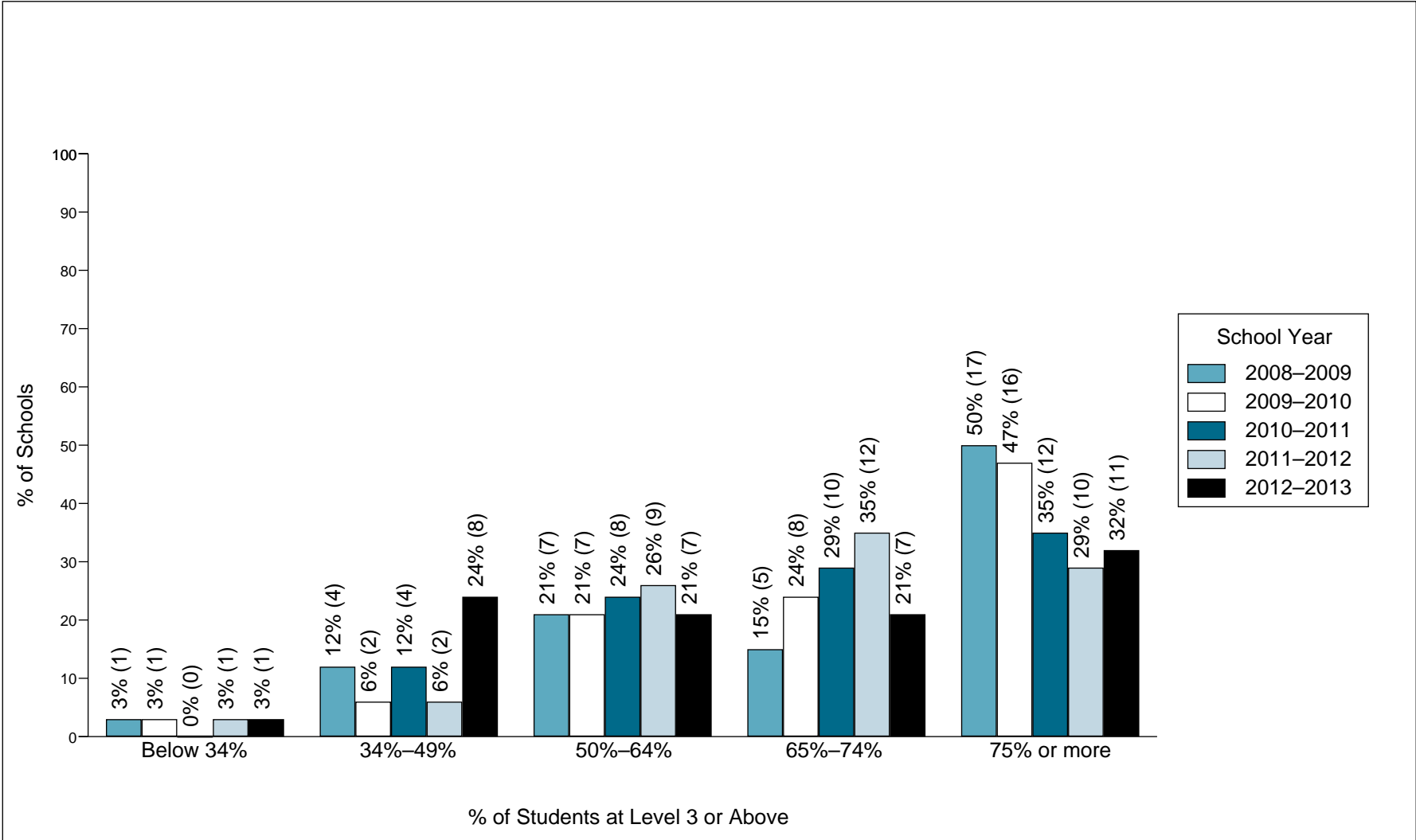

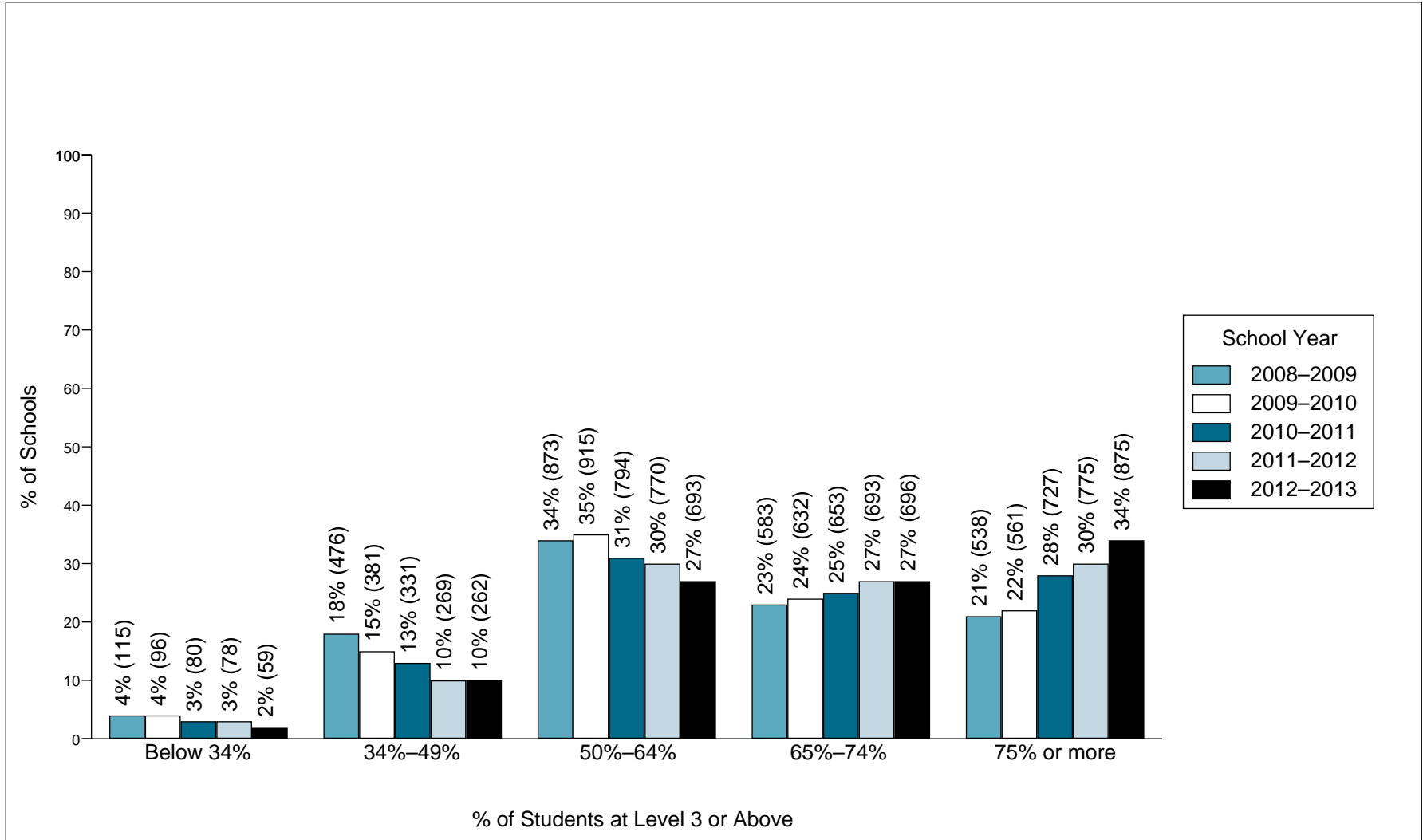

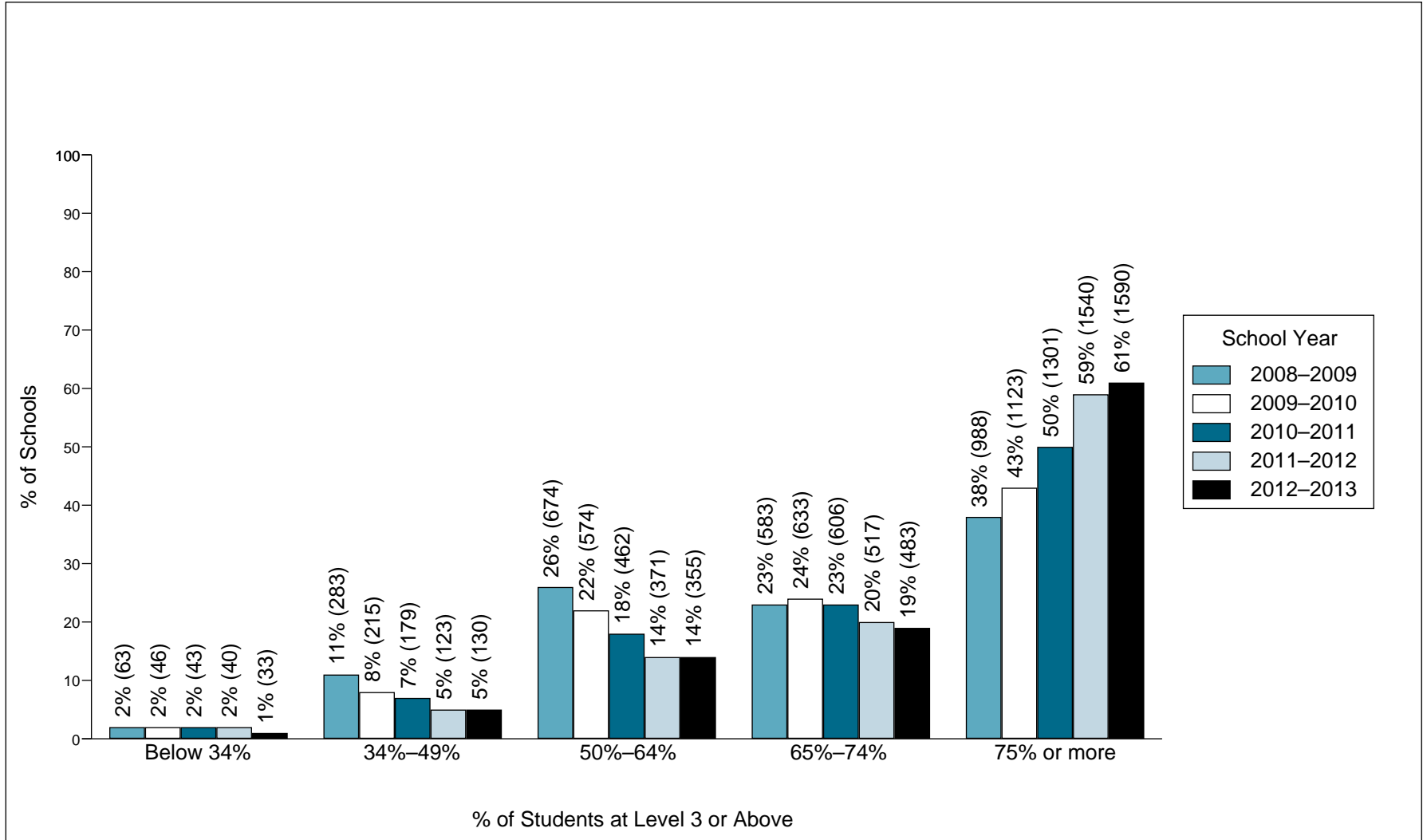

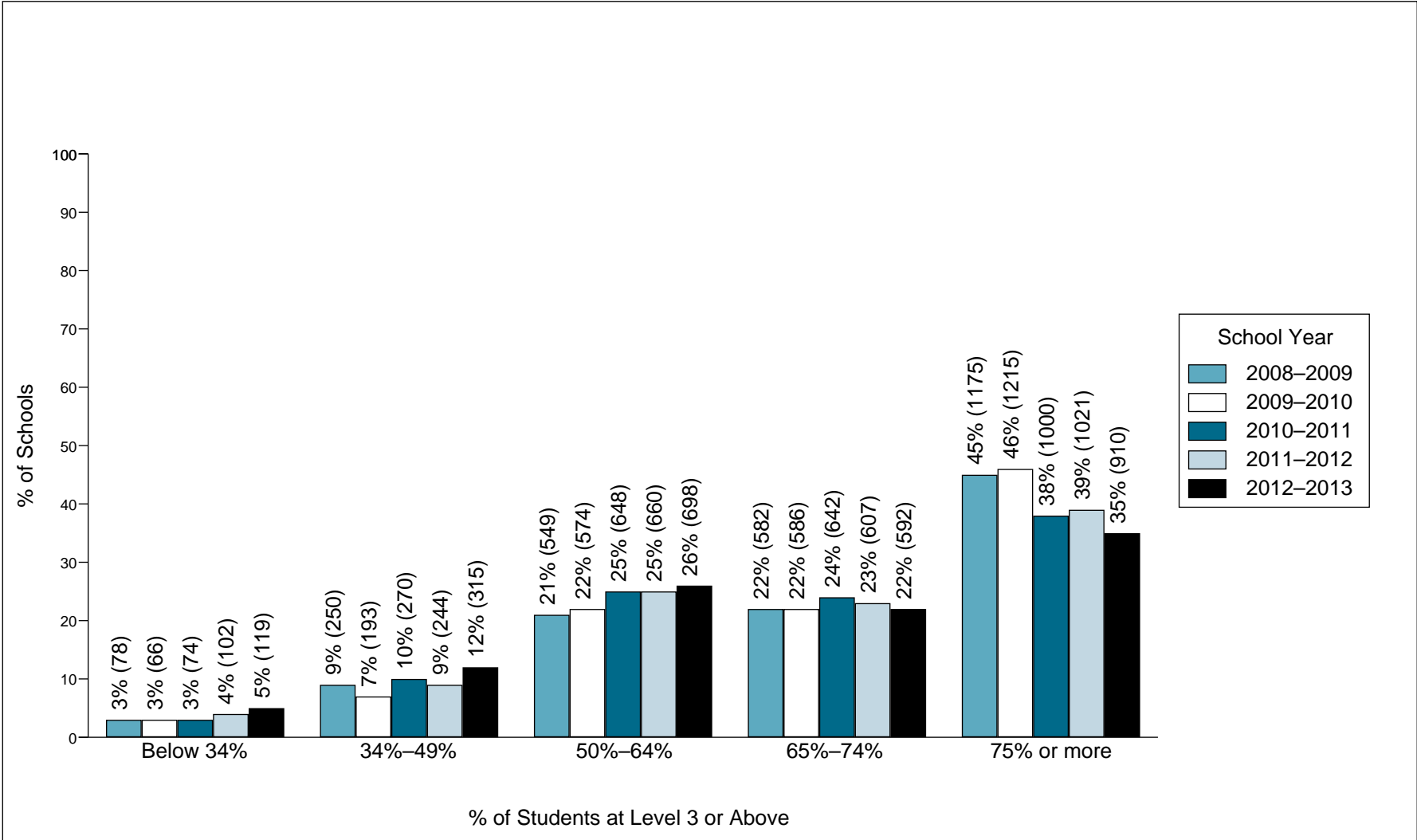
